THINK ABOUT IT THIS WEEK

Palm Sunday is a day of celebration, but also of challenge. As Jesus entered Jerusalem, the crowds welcomed Him with joy, expecting a king who would overthrow their oppressors. But Jesus came in humility, riding on a donkey, not to conquer by force, but to save through love and sacrifice. Do we follow Jesus as He truly is, or only when He meets our expectations?

Reflection Questions

- What expectations do I place on Jesus? Do I follow Him for who He is or for what I want Him to be?
- How do I respond when Jesus challenges me instead of affirming my plans?
- What might it look like to lay down my own "cloak"—my pride, fears, or agenda—to fully embrace Jesus as King?

A Prayer for the Week

Jesus, you are the King I did not expect, but the King I truly need. Help me to welcome You into my life, not just with words of praise, but with a heart of surrender. Teach me to trust You, even when Your way is different from my own. Lead me in humility, love, and faithfulness this Holy Week. Amen.

Final Thought

Palm Sunday invites us to move from celebration to commitment. As we journey through Holy Week, let us not only wave palm branches but also lay down our lives in surrender, trusting Jesus as our true King.
